One of the fundamental aspects of *Amoris Laetitia* is the relationship between pastoral practices and moral theology; this seems to be a "novum", something original, which prompts us to think of moral theology in a different way. In this approach, one does not merely repeat what has been said, but one reflects theologically on the basis of pastoral practice. This approach, starts from within an ecclesial horizon and is also ready to re-think theological and moral issues in a constructive dialogue with human experience. This experience is considered both universal and always contextualised by particular cultures and personal events.

# Target

The target of the conference is to celebrate the five year anniversary of *Amoris Laetitia*, in response to the invitation of the Dicastery for Laity, Family and Life. Believing that this papal teaching has continuing significance both for the theology of marriage and the family and for moral theology in general, the conference aims to explore the critical issues, provocations, and ideas that emerged from the Apostolical Exhortation. Furthermore, it seeks to understand them in greater depth and to further explore the application of an evolving theological-moral reflection on, and its pastoral implications.
